- Has the school fulfilled its obligations toward the victims and their families?
- Has the school fulfilled its obligations toward the police authorities?
- Has the school fulfilled its obligations to report to its accrediting bodies and to implement their recommendations?
- Has the school fulfilled its obligations to inform its stakeholders?

As a long-term student I always knew that the school expected a high level of integrity from me. Students and alumni should expect no less from the school's board and administration. Do the right thing!
