Subject: Additional scope for Moyer investigation

Dear Jim Dowden,

I wrote to Stephanie Toppino on June 10, 2014 and asked her to have the board include the following in the Ropes & Gray scope:

"Get the help of the [Tokyo] Metropolitan Police to try and match suicides by young Japanese women in the last 20-25 years with girls who were in contact with Moyer on his education programs and were potentially molested. Investigate whether Moyer was named in suicide notes or verbally to confidants before the suicides. This is a relevant part of the consequences of the school's failure to stop this known serial pedophile abuser's contacts with children."

I realize I haven't mentioned this to you directly, but it is an important issue to consider and I hope ASIJ sent this to you. Suicide is more common in Japan, and you can't be sure you have found the full extent of Moyer's crimes against women without turning over this stone. I urge you to do so if this is not yet thoroughly investigated.
